City Hall Plaza is a short 1.6 mile walk from the Bank of America Boston Marathon® Expo, across the Boston Marathon Finish Line, through Frederick Law Olmsted's famed Public Garden and Boston Common, along the Freedom Trail by historic sights such as the Granary Burying Ground and to the Mayoral seat of the City of Boston at City Hall Plaza. Explore a little further and visit Faneuil Hall, the bustling Seaport District, or experience world famous cuisine of Boston's Italian North End neighborhood.

Q: Where do I pick up my bib?
A: On the 2nd floor. Make sure to have your digital number pick-up pass ready to display when picking up your bib. There is a booth where you can get this pass if you forgot it, or you can get assistance from a roaming volunteer with an iPad. Participants can also look up their digital number pick-up pass online through www.baa.org.

Q: What do I need to pick-up my bib?
A: All athletes will need to show their number pick-up QR code, and a valid photo-ID to pick up their bibs. Only registered athletes are allowed to pick up their bibs.

Q: Where is the closest MBTA station?
A: Hynes Convention Center (B,C,D-Green Line), Copley (B,C,D,E-Green Line), Prudential (E-Green Line) and Back Bay (Orange Line and Commuter Rail).

Q: Is there a lactation space at the Expo?
A: Yes, a private Mamava Lactation Pod is offered by the Hynes Convention Center and is available to all Expo guests. It is located on the 1st floor in the South Lobby, near the Prudential Center entrance, adjacent to the restroom. To unlock and access the Mamava Lactation Pod, please download the Mamava Mobile App.

Q: Where is the finish line?
A: The finish line is on Boylston Street 0.4 miles from the Boylston Street entrance to the Convention Center.

Q: Where are the buses on race morning?
A: Buses for athletes to take to the Athletes' Village in Hopkinton will be located between the Boston Common and Boston Public Garden on Charles Street.

Q: How may I track a runner on my phone?
A: With the B.A.A. Racing App downloadable via the Apple App and Google Play stores. Track your runner, search for your favorite participants by name, bib, or hometown and view their live location on the course as well as get frequent updates as they start, pass timing marks, and finish!
