PROHIBITED ITEMS LIST




BAGS

Backpacks, or any similar items carried over-the-shoulder including handbags



CERTAIN CONTAINERS

Including glass, cans or any container capable of carrying more than 1 liter of liquid



COSTUMES

Including those covering the face or any non-form-fitting, bulky outfits extending beyond the perimeter of the body



PACKAGES

Or bulky items larger than 12x12x6 inches



LARGE BLANKETS

Including comforters, duvets, sleeping bags



FIREWORKS

Or flammable liquids, fuels or explosives



COOLERS

of any kind



WEAPONS

Or items of any kind that may be used as weapons including firearms, knives, pepper spray, etc.



PROPS

Including sporting equipment, flagpoles, hard objects, and military and fire/gear



SUITCASES

of any kind
