



The B.A.A. 10K presented by Mass General Brigham Cancer Institute features a breathtaking course with scenic views of Boston and Cambridge. Starting on Charles Street adjacent to Boston Common and the Public Garden, participants run north, crossing over the Longfellow Bridge in the opening mile. With the Charles River and Boston skyline on the left, athletes run along Memorial Drive past the Mass. Ave. Bridge, and turn around just prior to the B.U. Bridge. After turning around, the cityscape again comes into view approaching and crossing over the Mass. Ave. Bridge back into Boston. The final two miles feature Kenmore Square with its iconic Citgo sign, then following a "right on Hereford, left on Boylston" participants cross over the Boston Marathon finish line. Athletes will turn onto Charles Street where the finish—and post-race celebration—is located on Boston Common.
